TextWrangler Installation Process

After downloading TextWrangler from the Internet, you should see a window similar to what is below.



If you do not see this window, double-click on the .dmg file that you downloaded and it should show this window.

You need to drag the TextWrangler icon into the Applications folder on the right.

Using TextWrangler to Create an HTML file

Once you open TextWrangler, you will see a blank document. To turn this document into an HTML file, perform a "File>Save As..."



Type your file name with a .html extension and click "Save".

You can now start typing your HTML tags and creating your webpage – notice that TextWrangler highlights your HTML tags.
